To maintain their health and safety, students will not share personal supplies, so please make sure supply boxes are adequate and able to hold pencils, glue sticks, scissors, colored pencils, pens, highlighters, etc. Supply boxes need to fit inside the desk. Some consumable items will need to be replenished throughout the year.

Your student needs:

- No. 2 pencils (mechanical with No. 2 lead is acceptable)
- Pens – red and blue
- Colored pencils
- Highlighters
- Dry erase markers
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Ruler 12' with inches and centimeters
- Notebook paper (college or wide ruled) – 2 packs (one in student's binder and one will be kept in the classroom's cabinet for later use)
- Graph paper – 1 pack
- Composition notebooks – 5 (for taking notes in math, science, and language) Write students' name on each one and label three of them "Math", "Science", and "Language". The other two will be kept in the classroom's cabinet for later use.
- **English Standard Version Bible** (for weekly scripture memorization)
- Three ring binder with folders and pockets to organize homework
- Book bag of your choice (no wheels and tasteful please)
- Box of plastic forks for the cafeteria (boys)
- Box of plastic spoons for the cafeteria (girls)
- Ream of white copy paper (for our class and for art)
